SCRIP NEWS...

We have tabulated the results of our 40 family's using Scrip Campaign. During the period from our introduction on Easter weekend until June 3rd, we had 7 new families sign up to use Scrip, 11 families used Scrip that have not purchased for over a year and 4 families that have not used Scrip in the last 6 months. With the regular Scrip users,

we achieved a total of 41 families who used Scrip during that period. A hearty thank you to all and our invitation is open for anyone who has not tried Scrip or purchased Scrip lately. Of those using Scrip, a total of \$466.62 was generated for the General Fund and \$333.72 toward tuition for a total of \$800.34 of revenue generated. This is from 40 families who used Scrip at least once during this period! If we continue this for the year, that \$800 can turn into significant dollars being generated for our mission and ministries. Thank you again for your participation and please use Scrip weekly for your purchases and see how we can make an impact to our ministry here at Zion.
