ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN--MICHIGAN RESUMES OPERATIONS

Unexpectedly coinciding with the world-wide outbreak of the Corona virus, the first international shipment of humanitarian relief from Orphan Grain Train—Michigan reached impoverished, disabled, and needful people in Kyrgyzstan, Central Asia. Struggling women and men, many elderly with mask-covered faces searched through 1,400 boxes of clothing, medical supplies, and other equipment which had been shipped in November from the Sebewaing Orphan Grain Train Center. The 40-foot shipping container held clothing and relief materials all donated by caring people in Michigan. Orphan

Grain Train—Michigan is currently restocking its warehouse to reach another corner of the world in Christ's Name. SCHOOL NEWS...

Daycare re-opens June 15th. We will be mask free for children of all ages. Parents will be asked to drop off at the south playground doors only. Any adult guests that go past our second entryway doors will be asked to wear a mask. The summer day camp program begins with two groups: K-third grade and 4th-6th grade. Registration for school is open for all grades, three-year old preschool through eighth grade. Our school registration is also on our website in the forms section. We will still offer tours and visits for families this summer, but we will ask to tour in the evenings after daycare is done for the day.

MUSIC ADMINISTRATOR NEWS...

As we are trying to figure out the safest and most effective way to teach music at the daycare and school this year, I'm coming to you for prayer and monetary support.

I would like to supply each child, Pre-3 to 8th grade, with a "Zion Music Bag". Each bag will cost between \$10 -\$15 per student depending on the age group and musical instruments needed for their grade. A typical bag for elementary students should each have: a canvas bag, note book or 3 ring binder with written materials, egg shaker, scarf, drum sticks, plastic pail, a ball and a music CD or USB stick. The students would each keep their bag and use it in the class or take home, if online learning is necessary. They would also be able to use it or pass it down to their siblings in the future. This will cut down on the exposure to germs and COVID, help with social distancing vs. sharing instruments and be flexible enough to use anywhere.
