"MASK WEARING AT CHURCH"

This is a reminder that according to an executive order by the Governor to wear masks at all times when indoors. In a recent document, Michigan District affirmed that "our actions as Christians are intended to serve God ... and also serve our neighbor in Jesus' name". It affirms that "wearing a face mask during a pandemic is not an infringement on our religious rights, nor does it hinder the exercise of our Christian Faith". Finally, in the document, Michigan District affirms that "wearing a face mask is not intended to protect us from infection from our neighbor, but rather to protect our neighbor from inadvertently being infected by us".

Because of these affirmations, Michigan District recommends that all in participation in worship to wear a mask and practice proper social distancing with the exceptions of the pastor or readers while speaking at the pulpit or lectern, those who have specific respiratory distress who cannot wear a mask, and for the short time that an individual is receiving the elements of the Sacrament.

OFTEN ASKED OF ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN

What particular donations do you take? This is a question not always easy to answer. Nearly every week someone will ask us at Orphan Grain Train about items so diverse we never considered them before. For example, someone recently asked whether Orphan Grain Train would take old motel drapes. Sometimes we have to decline the generosity as graciously as possible when items are not considered humanitarian in nature. But the simplest answer is that we gladly receive clothing ("gently used"), shoes, hospital equipment such as wheelchairs and walkers, quilts/bedding, stuffed toys, and operable bicycles. The essential aim of Orphan Grain Train is to share resources and bring Christ's name and character to needy people both far and near.
