SCRIP FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) - FAQ #1 - Why is Zion doing this? By purchasing gift cards through Scrip at Zion, Zion can collect on average 3-5% of the cost of the card without members having to spend any of their own money. Zion uses this money to support our ministry, by having additional funds in our General Fund to support our operations and outreach. At the direction of our members, they may apply their rebates to our school families to assist with their tuition costs. This also supports Zion's ministry to share the good news with our students and their families. Getting used to using gift cards does not take too much effort and we are always looking for ways to make this convenient. By ordering online, purchasing through your bank account and reloading cards, a week's worth of purchasing can be complete in a matter of minutes. An average family of four can easily raise \$1,000.00 in a year by using Gift Cards versus their credit card. We are asking you to consider this as part of your stewardship activities.
