- Last fiscal year nearly 5.4 million fortified rice meals were shipped to those hungry and malnourished worldwide.
- Only 1.95% of every dollar spent goes for administration and fundraising. 98.05% goes for helping those in need in the US and worldwide.
- Last fiscal year more than \$44.1 million worth of humanitarian aid and food was shipped to people in need in the US and around the world.
